

## Internal Linear Exams (ILEs) Overview 2018-19

The aims of the ILEs are to provide our pupils with a realistic experience of sitting exams and prepare our pupils for their actual external linear exams. By following JCQ exam regulations and using our invigilator team, pupils will become confident and familiar with the procedures and skills required to sit exams in the hall. The ILEs will also provide an accurate assessment of our pupils' abilities. Assessment grades will be shared with parents/ carers via Go4Schools. Teachers will use the ILEs to understand pupils' strengths and weaknesses and will provide useful feedback to all pupils. With few exceptions, all ILEs will be in the Sports Hall. To ensure a positive experience of ILEs is created for Y7 & 8 pupils, English and maths ILEs will be in classrooms yet still follow JCQ regulations; all other subjects will be in the Sports Hall. Y11 ILEs that are extra, and additional, to the two-week programmes will be in classrooms but will still follow the strict JCQ procedures.

For all years, a revision booklet will be provided two weeks before the ILEs and Mr Naisbitt will also do a specific year group ILE assembly.

Our Additional Resource Centre (ARC) will support any pupils with specific needs through the ILEs.
