RE: streamlined consequence and rewards logs on Go 4 Schools

We do hope that our pupils and their families are taking time to rest over the summer and look forward to welcoming all our pupils back Tuesday, 5th September.

To make Go 4 Schools even easier to follow for our staff, parents/carers and pupils, we have streamlined the consequence and reward logs into simple headings that link with our Consequence and Rewards System. Below is an example of the expectations; the expectations are linked to our school ethos- the 5Rs: Resilience, Resourcefulness, Respect, Responsibility, Reflection. All colleagues clearly set out these expectations in their lessons during Transition and they will provide a reminder to all our pupils in lessons during the first week back.

Rewards		Consequences	
	Clear expectations set, praise.	Chance	First warning to meet expectations
R1	Basic Expectations met, logged on G4S (+1)	C1	Expectations not met, logged on G4S (-1)
R2	Exceeding expectations, logged on G4S (+2)	C2	Repeatedly not met expectations, logged on G4S (-2)
R3	Consistently meeting/ exceeding expectations, logged on G4S (+3), contact with home.	C3	Refusal or persistently not meeting expectations, logged on G4S (-3), detention and contact with home.

When you look at Go 4 Schools in September, you will see fewer headings. Below are examples of the logs that you will be used to seeing. The scale goes up to R10 to recognise outstanding achievements and C5 for serious breaches of school rules. We are aiming to increase the ongoing communication between our parents/ carers and our staff team at Oakwood regarding your child's/ children's successes and areas that require improvement. To be successful requires a positive school and community partnership and we thank you for all the support you provide day in and day out.

We hope that you will find this streamlined version of Go 4 Schools supportive. Thinking ahead to September, this is also a good time to remind you of our uniform policy, in particular that leggings are not accepted unless worn with a skirt over the top; jeans (anything with rivets/ metal buttons) are not permitted and school shoes must be ALL black shoes (not boots or high tops) with no metal/ chrome badges or adornments and no coloured laces or logos.
